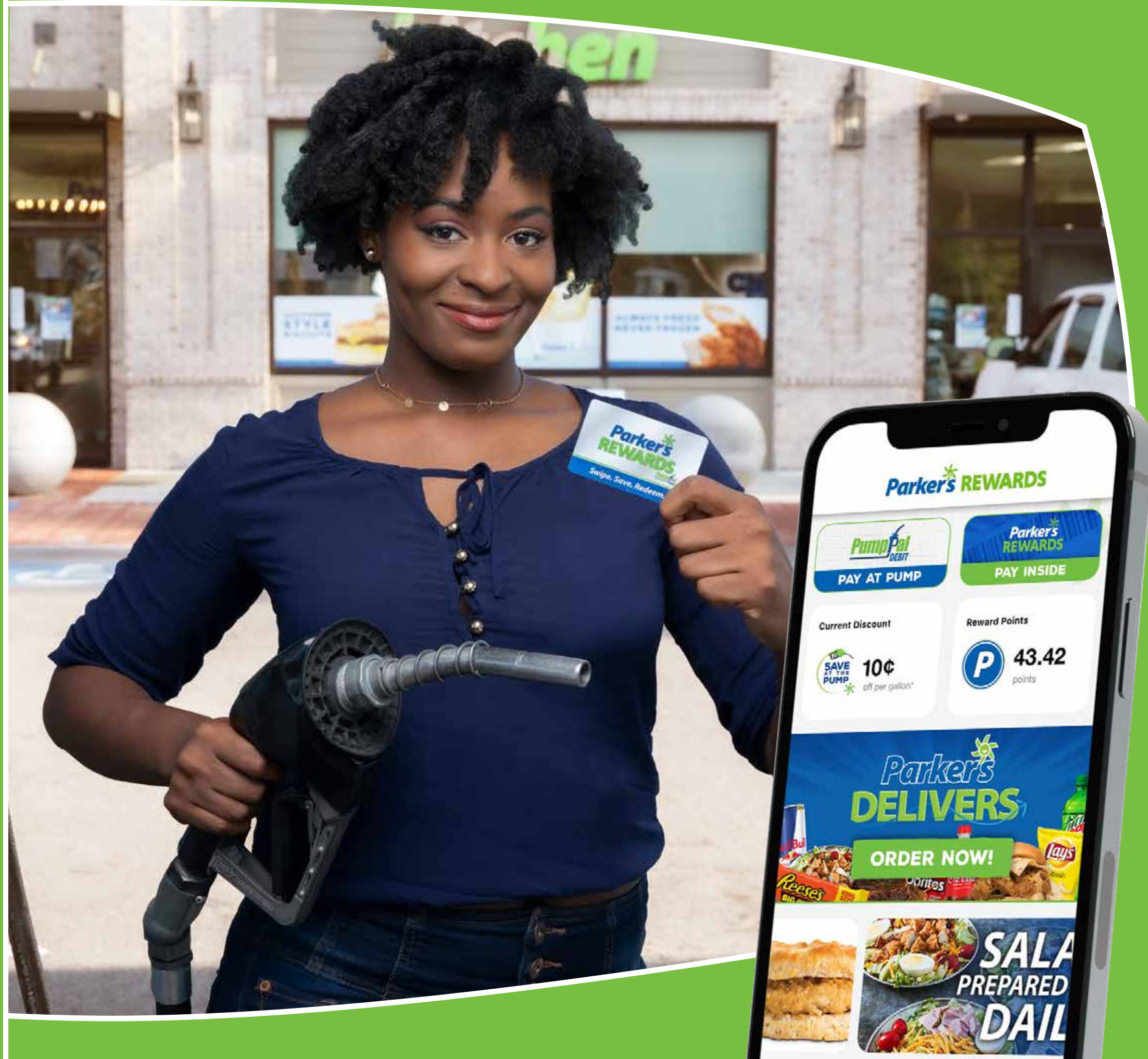

We are proud to be one of the most philanthropic companies in our industry, deeply committed to making a lasting impact. Over the past seven years, we have proudly donated over \$30 million.

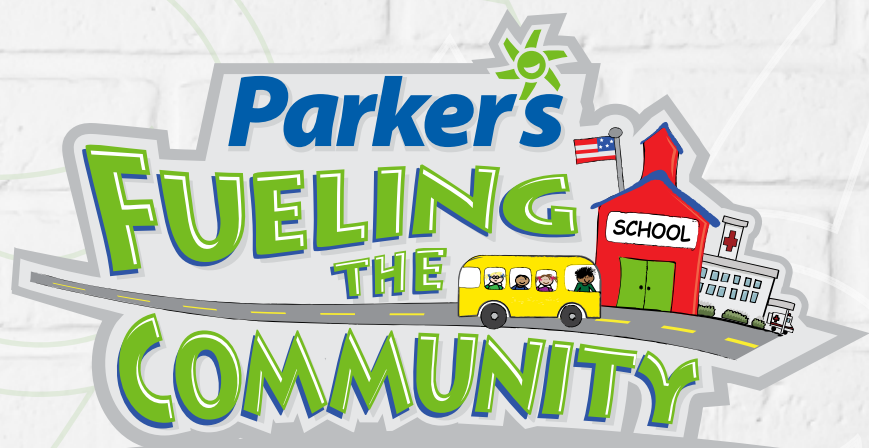

A Home for Women

In 2021, Parker's partnered with Union Mission in Savannah, GA, to establish Parker's House: A Home for Homeless Women—the first and only shelter for unaccompanied women experiencing homelessness in Coastal Georgia.

Parker's House offers emergency housing and comprehensive support services for up to 32 women at a time and provides critical support needed to help them take the next steps toward stability.

FIGHTING CHILDHOOD HUNGER

In 2022, we launched our hunger Round Up Campaign to support families and children facing food insecurity in Georgia and South Carolina. To enhance the impact, Parker's Kitchen matches 25% of all customer donations, benefiting local food banks, including America's Second Harvest, Golden Harvest, and Lowcountry Food Bank.

In 2023, the Parker's Community Fund donated \$1 million to America's Second Harvest of Coastal Georgia to support a new Chatham County facility, expanding aid to food-insecure communities across 21 counties.





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EMPOWERING LOCAL HEROES

In 2024, we partnered with Wounded Warrior Project and raised \$300,000 to support injured veterans in Georgia and South Carolina through our Round-Up Campaign. Parker's Kitchen matches 25% of customer donations, further amplifying our support for local veterans.

Our goal is to offer veterans and their families access to the resources they need. We are committed to making a positive impact across our footprint and proud to support Wounded Warrior Project in this mission.

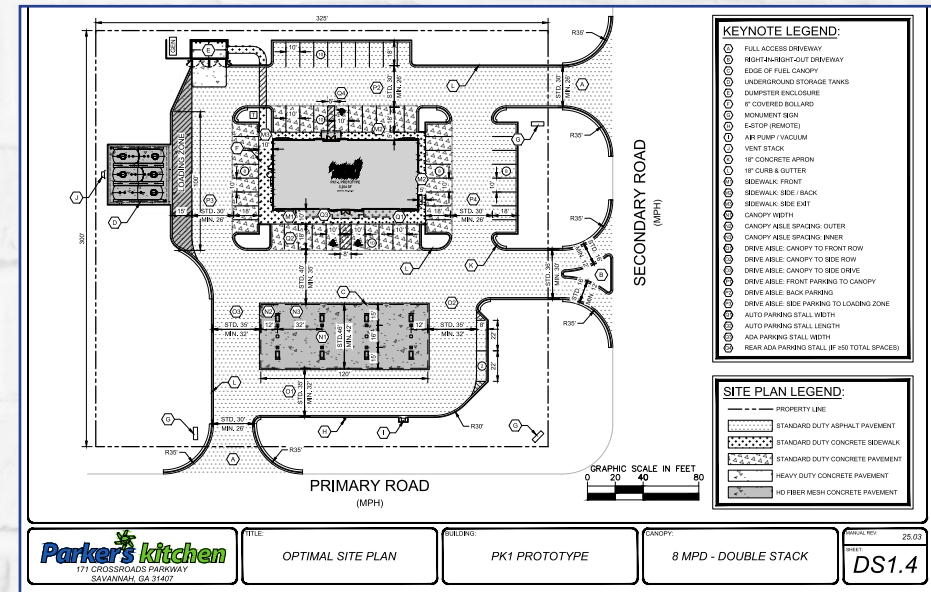
